## **Secretary's Report**

Raul moved to accept the minutes of September 28th. Krista seconded. Approved 3-0-2. Krista and Jim abstained.

Amy provided an overview of the many facets of Special Education and other student services.

#### **Budget Planning**

Andy addressed priorities for the next budget. The current draft budget is about \$200,000 over the preliminary Budget Committee guidance.

Highlights include a repair of a water tank at an estimated cost of \$40,000. Andy recommends that we add \$60,000 annually to the Maintenance Trust Fund. In addition, he encouraged the committee to consider options for funding the roofing maintenance. Andy also discussed options for updating athletic fields, including use of the athletic trust fund. He also said that we should consider purchasing 1 or more vans to support vocational transportation since this is a cost effective way to reduce special education transportation cost. He suggested that the committee should consider mechanisms for replenishing contingency funds that get expended.

Raul moved that we set preliminary guidance for the FY19 operating budget of \$21,367,795.00, based on a 2.2% inflation factor. Brian seconded. The motion passed 3-1-1. Darlene, Raul and Brian voted in favor. Krista opposed and Jim abstained.
